PRACTICAL INFORMATION

for your trip to KISC

High up in the mountains, Kandersteg can be found in the Jungfrau-Aletsch region of the Swiss Alps, about 65km from Bern or a 1-hour train journey away. You can reach us by plane, train or car and the local bus from the station is free if you wear your scarf! If you're walking from the station, we're about 20 minutes away at the end of the valley.

ABOUT KANDERSTEG

A traditional Alpine village in the heart of the Bernese Oberland, a UNESCO World Heritage site.

Surrounded by stunning mountains, epic waterfalls, and beautiful nature, Kandersteg has many shops and services to make your stay more comfortable, including restaurants, hotels, grocery stores, a doctor's practice, banks, cash machines, and a garage. The village also has an indoor rock-climbing centre, ice rink, and curling field.

WEATHER IN DECEMBER & JANUARY

Temperature

See you in 100 years will take place at the beginning of winter, between December and January. During the event, we can expect temperatures between -2°C (28.4°F) at night and 6°C (42.8°F) at midday.

Rain & Snow

During a typical winter, we can expect rain and Kandersteg to be covered in snow and approximately 5 rainy days in the month. Humidity is close to 88%.

Recommendations

The weather in the valley and the mountains tends to change quickly, so you must be ready for everything. We strongly recommend that you bring:

- Rucksack - 20 to 40 litres
- Waterproof hiking boots with ankle support (no trainers)
- Winter trousers and jacket - preferably waterproof
- Warm clothing - thermal base-layer, fleece (no jeans)
- Warm hat and gloves - preferably waterproof
- Sun protection - sun cream, sunglasses, hat
- Water bottle - minimum 2 litres
- Personal medication - EpiPen, asthma inhaler, etc.
- Reusable lunch box for your packed lunch

COVID SITUATION

At KISC, we follow the Swiss national health guidelines to tackle the covid pandemic. At the time of this Bulletin publication, the National Authorities do not have any mandatory requirements for entering or traveling in the country. However, we strongly recommend all participants are vaccinated against COVID-19 according to their National Health Authorities.

ACCOMMODATION TYPE

Indoor accommodation: This means staying in one of our buildings (shared rooms): Chalet or Sunneblick. This will be based on the most suitable allocations by our team. You will be provided with bedding, including sheets, and you are expected to keep the cleanliness of your allocated space.

Kanderlodge: The Kanderlodge is our building with more upscale accommodation. Every two rooms share their own private bathroom. There is also a fully equipped kitchen and dining area as a common area to use for all participants staying in the building.

FOOD SERVICES

The event offers Full Board service to all participants. The Full Board booking package includes all meals from the Centre, starting with a special New Year's Eve (NYE) dinner on December 31st and offers a Brunch on January 1st. This needs to be considered for any meals on arrival/departure days and any lateness to one of the meals needs to be announced to KISC staff in advance.



REGISTRATION AND FEES

Registration is open for the See you in 100 years. Check the booking form at [See you in 100 years | KISC 2023](#), and we will get back to you as soon as possible.

NSO WORLD SCOUT EVENT PARTICIPATION FEE CATEGORY BY COUNTRY

See you in 100 years event's fee system follows the "NSO World Scout Event participation fee category by country". This means if you are a member of an NSO from a category A, B or C country, you can get a discount of up to 75% on your accommodation.

Regardless of your selection of accommodation, all fees of the event include the following:

- Closing ceremony of KISC Centenary celebration
- Registration kit: scarf and badge

REGISTRATION FEES

You can check your preferred fees* based on your choice of food and accommodation, according to your country category, through **Annexe 1** below.

** All prices are in Swiss Francs (CHF) and include tourist tax.*

PAYMENT AND INSTALLMENT

The payment for See you in 100 years has to be paid in one transaction in order to confirm the booking, due 20 days after the confirmation of registration by KISC staff.

VISA

If a visa support letter is required, you must send the full payment before KISC issues the requested letter. You need to communicate your request at an early stage as our staff might take some time to send you the letter.

Refunds will not be considered when the denial of a visa to attend See you in 100 years occurred when an individual did not follow the application procedures, deadlines, or processes as outlined by the appropriate governmental authority. The only instance where a refund can be made is when visa issuance is denied by the Swiss government. In such a case, relevant evidence should be submitted.

Requests for refunds of the See you in 100 years payment will be considered only under the following conditions:

- Visa denial requests must include the following information with any request:
 - Booking number
 - Copy of visa appointment email (with date)
 - Copy of visa denial letter. The letter must show evidence of why the visa request was denied (with date)
- Must only include a request for refund of See you in 100 years payment.

Once our team gathers all requests, we will evaluate each case based on the evidence given and we will communicate with the groups/contingents the decision made by our management team.
